Payment Plans:

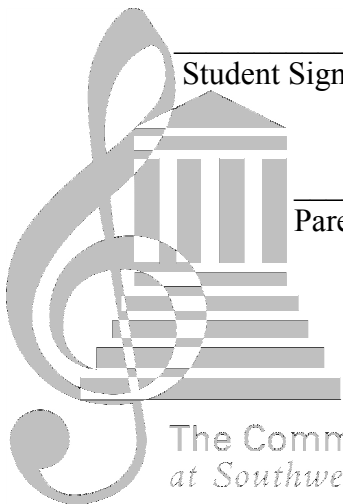
- We encourage monthly payments for all lessons, 10% of lesson fees are strictly for administration and general building purposes.
- If you are taking classes or are involved in an ensemble we ask those charges be paid in full, upfront. However, if you are not able to pay as a lump-sum we can work out a monthly payment plan.
- I will pay my commitment fee as well as my monthly lesson fees, as they apply, on time, if you are not paid in full at the end of each semester you/your child will not be able to participate in the CMS the following semester until all balances are zero.
- If you chose to discontinue lessons/classes at the Community Music School you must give a one month notice, or stop lessons at the end of a semester term. I understand if I quit the Community Music School and wish to rejoin I will have to pay a new, non-refundable commitment fee.
