- Script and Sketch Writing

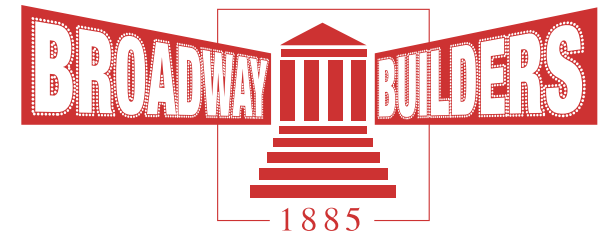
Mentor with performers in training!

Train with professionals!

You'll work with outstanding Southwestern College faculty members:

Roger Moon - director of theatre and associate professor of speech and theatre. He is a Kennedy Center American College Theatre Festival Gold Medallion Recipient accomplished in direction, musical theatre performance, and script and sketch writing.

Allyson Moon - associate professor of speech and theatre. She is also a Kennedy Center American College Theatre Festival Gold Medallion recipient and a specialist in actor training, movement, and improvisational acting.

Cynthia Compton - affiliate faculty member accomplished in musical theatre direction and accompaniment.

Specialists in vocal performance and dance will also instruct festival participants.

Invest in your future!

The full cost of the festival is \$450, which includes a double room in an SC residence hall for six nights, three meals per day, instruction with professionals and one on one mentoring, insurance coverage, and supplies.

A commuter option is also available if you choose not to stay overnight on campus. The commuter's cost for the festival is \$350, which includes meals, insurance, instruction and supplies.

Registration is due June 27, 2011. If space is available, late registration will be accepted through July 6, 2011, on a first-come, first-served basis. Registration will be held to a maximum of 40.
