

Southwestern College Overnight Rules and Regulations

Alcohol & Drug Policy: The possession, use, or distribution of alcoholic beverages or illicit drugs by students or visitors is strictly prohibited on the property of the college or as part of any college activity taking place off college property. Southwestern College adheres to Kansas State laws regarding drug and alcohol use.

Observing Quiet Hours: Students are asked to respect the fact that others may be studying and to keep noise such as music, group discussion, television, etc. at a reasonable level at all times. Quiet hours for all on-campus housing are from 10:00 pm – 10:00 am with **24 hour courtesy hours – be respectful of fellow residents.**

Visitation: Warren, Reid, Sutton, Shriwise, Honors and Broadhurst have 24 hour visitation. Visitation is allowed in Cole and Wallingford Halls' rooms and hallways by members of the opposite sex during the following hours:

In-Room Visitation Hours:

9:00 am – 12:00 am Sunday – Thursday
9:00 am – 2:00 am Friday & Saturday

Lobby Hours:

9:00am – 2am Sunday – Thursday
24 hours Friday & Saturday

Room/Facilities Damages: Guests and visitors must leave rooms and facilities in the condition in which they were found at the beginning of their stay. Any damages to rooms, facilities, or furnishings may be assessed to the guest responsible for the damage.

Fire Drill and/or Fire Alarms: If the fire alarms should activate during your stay, you must leave the building immediately. This includes times when the College or residence hall is conducting a fire drill.

Personal Property: We encourage you not to leave your personal property laying unattended. The College is not responsible for any lost or stolen property during your stay on campus.

Dangerous items: Objects that threaten the safety of residents are not permitted on campus. This includes but is not limited to; knives in excess of 6 inches, decorative swords, guns (paintball, air soft, pellet, etc.), explosives, and fireworks

Smoking/No Smoking: Smoking, tobacco use, or vaping is not permitted inside any campus building, including student rooms.

Pets: Pets are not allowed inside of the residence halls

Seat Belts: Southwestern College requires all occupants of its vehicles to wear a seat belt at all times. This policy is for your safety.

Sexual Misconduct: Southwestern College prohibits sexual misconduct, stalking, dating violence, and domestic violence.
