

Information for 2020-2021 Jinx Dance Team Auditions

Dear Jinx Dance Applicant,

Congratulations on your decision to audition for the SC Jinx Dance Team! Here is the information for our upcoming auditions on Saturday April 18th 8:00am-12:00pm. Auditions will be held at White P.E. I look forward to meeting you and GOOD LUCK!

Audition Schedule:

April 3- A video will be posted on the Builder Cheer & Dance FACEBOOK . The video will have a 30 second routine that you will need to learn on your own and have ready to perform on the day of auditions. This routine will then be added to new choreography that you will learn on audition day.

April 18-

08:00-09:00- practice time

09:00-10:00- Perform routines for the Judges

12:00-1:00- Interviews with Coach/Judge

2:00- Results are posted.

3:30-7:30- If you are chosen to be a part of the Jinx Dance Team, we will have a mandatory meeting to go over dates and uniform info.

To be turned in Saturday April 18th:

- Jinx Dancer Application (typed)
- Photo of Applicant (4x6 size is perfect)
- 2 letters of Recommendation (from your dance teacher/coach and community Leader, teacher, Pastor, etc.)

Frequently Asked Questions:

Q: What should I wear to auditions?

A: Please wear all black. A black dance top or fitted black tank top and black boy shorts or “hot shorts”. **NO HALF TOPS or SPORTS BRAS please.** Please wear a cover up when traveling to and from the audition area. Full hair and makeup is encouraged.

Q: What should I do about meals and lodging for the audition weekend?

A: There are a variety of hotels and eateries in the Ark City/Winfield area. SC Jinx Dancers will not be providing any meals during the audition weekend. Each candidate is encouraged to bring a snack (cereal bar, fruit, veggies, etc.) and water for Saturday’s event.

Q: Are auditions open to the public?

A: No. Auditions are closed to the public and parents/family members. Interviews with the director will also be closed to the public and parents/family members.

Q: Do Jinx Dancers receive a scholarship?

A: Yes. Each member of the Jinx Dance Team will earn a athletic scholarship starting at \$3,000 yearly that goes up dependent on skill level.

Q: How much does it cost to be a Jinx Dancer?

A: There is no fee for the audition day. Should a candidate make the team there will be a equipment fee off \$150. Which will cover tights, practice clothes, shoes and any other uniform items.

*Q: Where do the Jinx Dancers perform?
Will the Jinx Dancers travel throughout the school year?*

A: Yes, In the fall semester, we perform at all home football, volleyball, and basketball games. We host a Football Playoff conference where we

will also perform at all home playoff games. During the Spring Semester the team will perform at both men's and women's home basketball games, and traveling to away tournament games. We will travel to our Collegiate Competition in February, and to a few local guest performances at various events. Any other travel plan information will be given to the team members as the need arises.
