

CAEP Standard A.4.2: Satisfaction of Completers


2022-2023

The following data was collected from advanced program completers graduating in spring 2023. One hundred percent of respondents reported satisfaction with their program preparation and agreed they were prepared for their current position. Fifty-seven percent of respondents reported a promotion based on their degree completion, and 100% reported employment in a K-12 school or an institution of higher learning. 
Are you using your graduate degree in your current position? 7 responses



Are you employed by a school district or a higher education institution? 7 responses




Did you receive a promotion or use your degree to obtain a new position? 7 responses




Did your degree adequately prepare you for your position?




Are you satisfied with the preparation you received at Southwestern? $\ensuremath{^{7}}\xspace$ responses
